1. BAKED PRODUCTS – Each item to be completely covered with plastic wrap, to be judged on general appearance, flavor and texture
2. CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES – Entries to be in pint or quart jars of clear glass with two-piece self-sealing lids, to be judged on general appearance, quality, and neatness of package.
3. JELLIES, JAMS, AND BUTTERS – To be in standard clear jelly glasses, covered with two-piece self-sealing lids; to be judged on appearance, flavor, consistency, and neatness of package (no paraffin).
4. PICKLES AND RELISHES – Entries to be in pint or quart jars of clear glass with two-piece, self-sealing lids to be judged on size, uniformity, clearness, color and appearance.
